Anointing of the Sick

Is anyone among you suffering? He should pray. Is anyone in good spirits? He should sing praise. Is anyone among you sick? He should summon the presbyters [priests] of the church, and they should pray over him and anoint [him] with oil in the name of the Lord, and the prayer of faith will save the sick person, and the Lord will raise him up. If he has committed any sins, he will be forgiven.



Sacrament: An efficacious sign of grace, instituted by Christ and entrusted to the Church, by which divine life is dispensed to us through the work of the Holy Spirit.

Every Sacrament is:

- A faith event
- An encounter with Jesus Christ
- An encounter with some specific aspect of the ministry and life of Jesus
- Tailored to a certain TIME, EXPERIENCE, EVENT and/or NEED in our human life/journey
- Somehow involves the life and work of the whole Church – not just me, alone, apart
- An anticipation of a full and final salvation in the eternal life of heaven

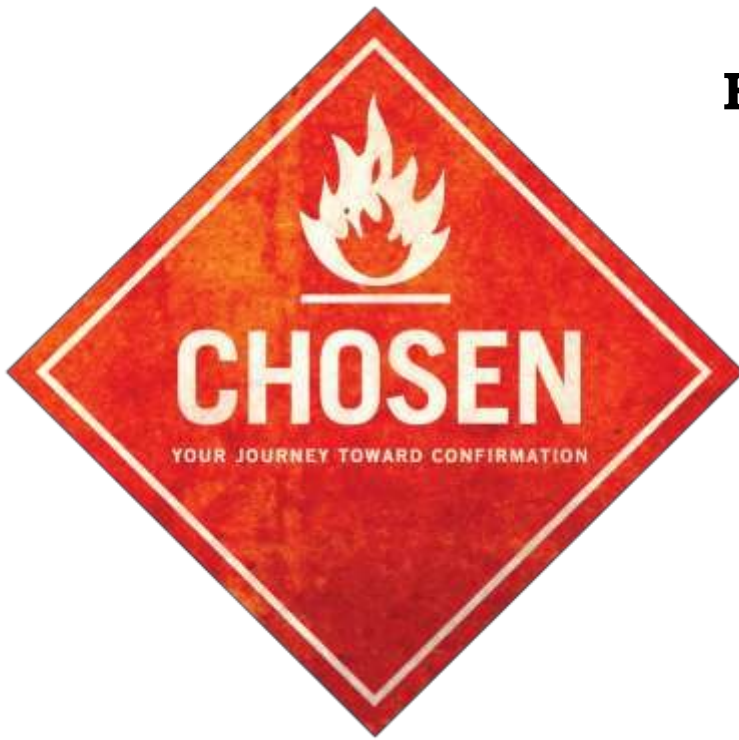

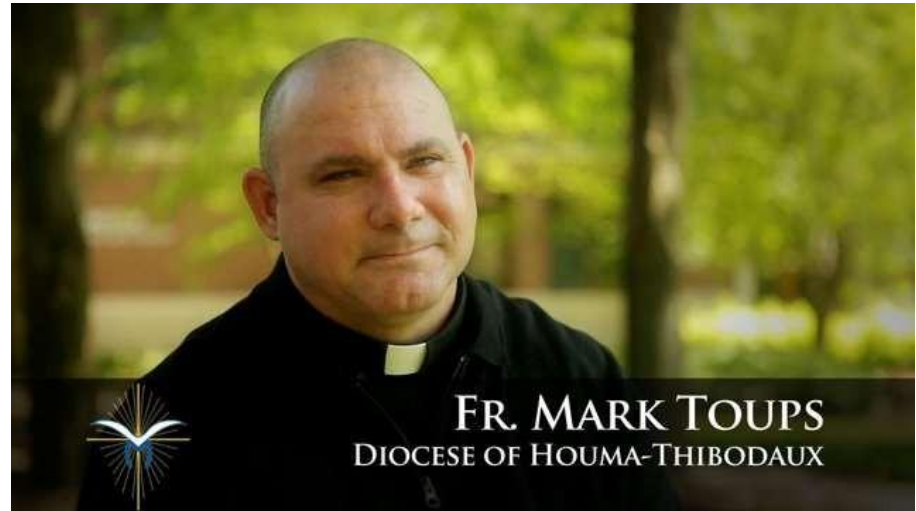

For Lent –

- **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are obligatory days of ***fasting*** and ***abstinence*** for Catholics.
- **Fridays** during Lent are obligatory days of ***abstinence***.
- For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on ***fasting*** are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.
- The norms concerning ***abstinence from meat*** are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

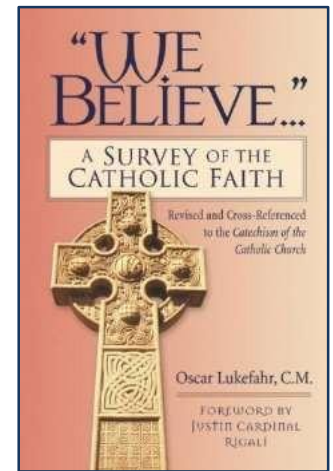
